Every year we are absolutely amazed by the generosity of donors like you, and 2019 was truly a transformational year! Together, we raised almost 1 MILLION dollars to support and enhance vital programs that positively impact people's lives in our community.

Because of you, there is a greater support for people fighting cancer with the addition of the new PET/CT scanner in the Heptner Cancer Center at Campbell County Health. PET/CT makes cancer care more convenient and comfortable for patients than it has been before. In 2019 more school age kids in Campbell County were able to get a free flu shot through the Vaccines for Influenza Prevention (VIP) Project. This program has continued to decrease school absences and keep kids learning. Donor dollars supported patients and families at Close to Home through hospice and hospitality services; resident activities at The Legacy, scholarships to increase healthcare education and supplementing Lifeline subscriptions to keep their costs down and enable seniors to stay independent.

Your generosity means more as we celebrated record-breaking community events like Paint Gillette Pink and Festival of Trees. These events support so many facets of healthcare and health improvements for our community.

Last year, my family and I endured the heartache of my mother-in-law's diagnosis with the terminal illnesses of ALS and Alzheimer's. Sherry was a strong, hard-working leader in our community; never did we think this was going to be her future. Sherry endured a horrific illness, and was stricken with silence for almost a year. We did everything we could for her at home until we realized inpatient hospice care was the best medical decision we could make. Sherry moved into Close to Home Hospice, where she lived out her last days.

For most of my career with the Campbell County Healthcare Foundation, I helped build, raise funds, manage and advocate for the Close to Home Hospice Hospitality House. I never thought I would be on the opposite side of the facility as a family member of a hospice patient. As anyone who has been through this experience knows, I and my family spent a lot of time sitting, waiting, praying and recycling fresh flowers in

her room as they made her smile. It is one thing to advocate for a mission that is part of your job, but it is another to advocate because it is something you lived and are passionate about. Close to Home helped my family during one of our most difficult times.

Close to Home offers an affordable place to stay because where you lay your head at night should be the least of your worries. Close to Home is just that, a place that provides the comforts of home when you need it most. I remain humbled to be part of such an incredible organization that recognizes the need to embrace those needing support while facing medical crisis and terminal illness.

Festival of Trees Committee

Helping our Senior Population

Roughly 5% of the 3,900 seniors in Campbell County rely on the Lifeline Emergency Response System to help keep them independent at home. Lifeline gives people the security of knowing that help can be summoned in an emergency at the press of a button. Lifeline is provided through the Home Health and Hospice department of Campbell County Health, and has been available to those who need it for over 30 years.

In 2019, increases in the cost to provide Lifeline services were going to result in an increase in monthly subscription fees for users, up to double the cost for some seniors. This increase could have been detrimental to those on fixed incomes, and

subscribers were understandably upset at the prospect.

The Festival of Trees Committee came to the rescue, with \$40,000 in additional financial support for the Lifeline program. Some may not know that the Festival of Trees began in 1992 as a way to support the Lifeline program through the purchase of new equipment. The success of the 27th Annual Festival of Trees provided the Committee with the ability to double their support to Lifeline with a gift of \$40,000. This generous gift ensured that Lifeline subscribers would not see a cost increase, keeping their monthly subscriptions to \$25 per month.

Funds raised at the walk go to support the Alzheimer's Association, with some funding coming back to The Legacy. The LAB exceeds at its mission, Enhancing the quality of life for all at The Legacy.

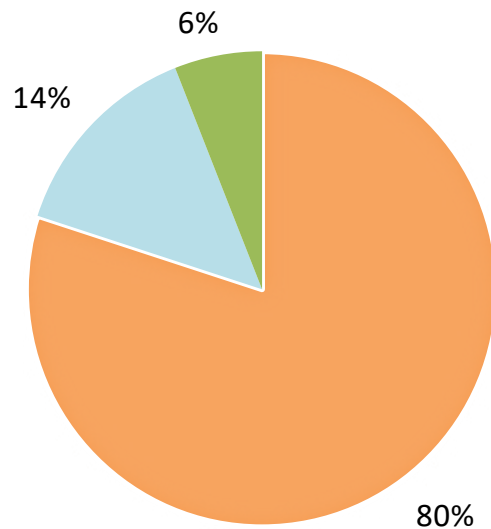

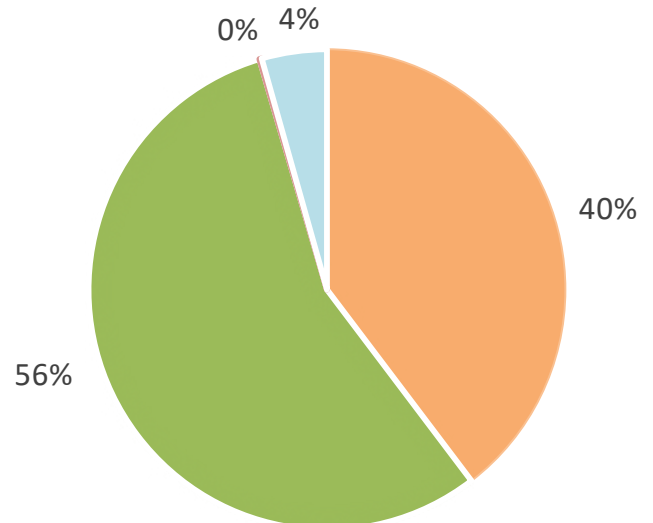

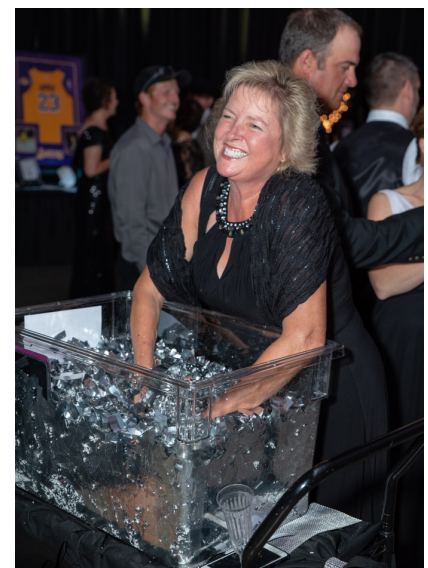
