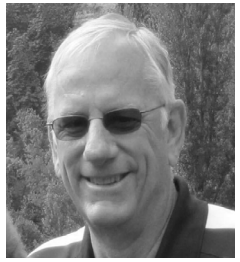

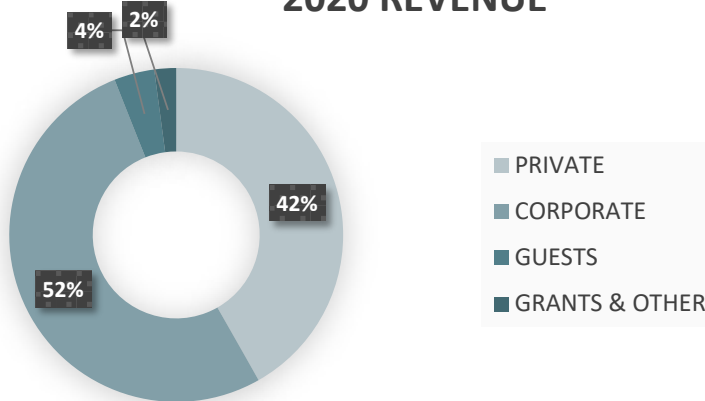

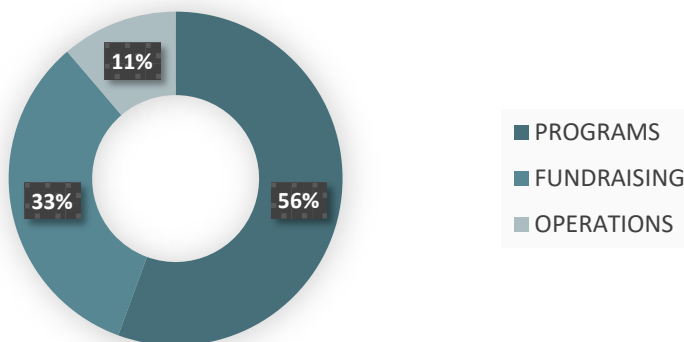
# FINANCIAL OVERVIEW

### KRIS CANFIELD, MD, GENERAL SURGEON



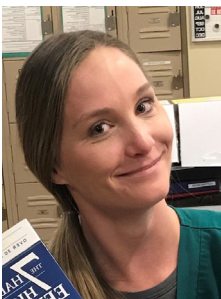
Dr. Canfield received numerous nominations, not just from his peers, but from patients as well. Kris has served in Gillette for the past 10 years as a general surgeon, dedicated to answering the surgical needs of the community. Dr. Canfield has worked on numerous surgical cases, but one that touched so many community members in Gillette as one trauma patient that spent over 10 hours in the operation room from a 2 vehicle, high speed collision on Highway 50. When Kris is not working, he is serving on regular mission trips to Mexico, Costa Rica and West Africa. He has even put himself in harm's way in Africa caring for patients during Civil Wars. Dr. Canfield has also served as Chief of Surgery at CCH.

### JULIE CENTNER, HEALTH SERVICES MANAGER, CC SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT



Not many people know there is a small medical practice in our local jail, called the Campbell County Jail Medical Associates. Constitutionally mandated healthcare services are provided to adult and juvenile inmates of the Detention Center. There are 5 full-time nurses and one physician. Services are provided 7 days a week, delivering all aspects of healthcare to incarcerated individuals. In 2008, Julie helped design the medical clinic during the Detention Center expansion project that increased inmate population from 160 to 300. In 2013, while continuing a full-time position, Julie graduated with a MS degree in the Family Nurse Practitioner program and received her Advanced Practice degree in 2014. Julie has brought a wealth of experience and education, even assisting Gillette College Nursing School with their preceptor program. Julie has been a member of the American Nurses Association, Wyoming Nurses Association, American Academy of Nurse Practitioners and Academy of Correctional Health Professionals. When Julie is not working she volunteers for the Women's Resource Center, Journey Church and Festival of Trees.

### KYLA KIMBALL, CLINICAL CARE SUPERVISOR, CCH



Kyla is the clinical care supervisor for the PACU (post anesthesia care unit) at CCH. Over the last year the surgery department has faced several challenges including decreased case volumes due to COVID-19 restrictions and the loss of their director. Kyla was asked to serve as interim director and she was proud to take on the challenge as a new leader. With the support of their Chief of Surgery, Kyla and her department started a "Move the Magnet" campaign, an initiative focused on time starts for cases, staff and surgeon satisfaction and OR productivity. Kyla served on the Gillette Abuse Refuge Foundation Board

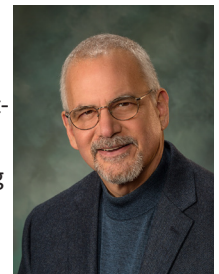
of Directors where she was able to influence the lives of victims of sexual assault and domestic violence. She is also active in the SANE (sexual assault nurse examiners) program and supports Fur Kids Foundation and Council of Community Services.

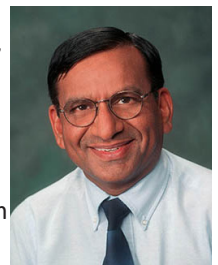
### ROBERT NEUWIRTH, MD, HOSPITALIST, INTENSIVIST, NEPHROLOGIST, CCH

Most recently in his role as Public Health Officer he has many added duties due to COVID. Dr. Patel has been a constant leader in our healthcare community demonstrating leadership and industriousness during his 29 years in our community.

# FORGING PHILANTHROPY

After 40 years in Gillette, Greg Dougherty is still looking for new ideas. He does not idle long, always looking for something to be involved in whether that be business ventures or just fun. He is also committed to making his community the best place to live, work and play.

Greg grew up one of ten kids on a farm in Waukon, Iowa. Growing up on a farm, he embraced hard work, an attribute that has stuck with him throughout his life. In Iowa, Greg decided to take a welding class at a local technical school, quickly earning his degree. He then moved to Wisconsin where he worked for a union-based welding company. Greg didn't like working for the "union" so in 1980 he followed his brother to Gillette, Wyoming as the boom brought many welding opportunities. Over three short years, Greg worked for a few construction companies before buying out his partners and turning the company into Greg's Welding. In last 38 years, Greg has turned his business from what was a small one- person shop to 100 plus employees and expansion into North Dakota. Greg has worked through the booms and busts but has always made an effort to support this community.

Greg's first volunteer experience was with the Society of Petroleum Engineers (SPE) working on their annual golf tournament and Crawfish Boil. Greg has been involved in the SPE for over 30 years raising funds for families in medical crisis and scholarships for petroleum engineering degrees. In 2008, the Healthcare Foundation started the Close to Home Hospice Hospitality House Campaign and Greg was one of the first donors to support. "I had a good friend Rick McElroy who was one of the founding members of the project and I believed in his vision. I thought this was a fantastic service to offer patients and families in our community."

Greg has also been instrumental in the success of Festival of Trees. When asked about his involvement, he smiled and began telling us about the first Hawaiian-themed tree he purchased for \$600. He still has that small tree. Greg has been buying trees from Festival for almost two decades. "I've actually only kept two trees of all the trees I've purchased. I enjoy buying trees and giving them away to someone who otherwise could not purchase a tree for themselves. I imagine their surprise when the gift is delivered to their door. I like them to know someone thought about them during the holidays." Greg has purchased close to 30 trees since his involvement in Festival of Trees.

He also has been known for purchasing the tree that wins the People's Choice award because that's the community's favorite tree. Greg likes supporting this community and giving back to people in need. Greg has supported many other causes of the Healthcare Foundation. He has supported residents of The Legacy through activities, Black Cat Ball's Outstanding Healthcare Awards and the Foundation's most recent project, the PET/CT Capital Campaign.

Greg recalls a time when he was touring a university for his son and his daughter stopped to look at a few pictures with titles below them on the wall. She looked at Greg and said, Dad you are just like them, a Philanthropist, you donate and help the community." She was right, Greg is just that. Greg Dougherty, Philanthropist.

## PEOPLE HELPING PEOPLE

CAMPCO Federal Credit Union has been in our community for decades. What began as a small membership credit union has now flourished into one of the more prominent financial institutions in Gillette and Campbell County. With growth, CAMPCO has made a generous presence in our community over the last few years, particularly in helping those in need. Kurt Thelen, recently retired president, saw a need for support for many social services in our community such as Council of Community Services, Blessings in a Backpack and the Campbell County Healthcare Foundation. Growing up, Kurt dealt with many family members stricken with cancer. He knew the importance of support and wanted to make a difference.

Kurt also instituted a giving culture within the employees of CAMPCO, "People Helping People". CAMPCO focuses on its Acts of Kindness whether that be serving on a board, volunteering your time, or giving back monetarily. With this new culture at CAMPCO, a group of employees started what has become an annual event, the CAMPCO 5k to support Paint Gillette Pink. The 5k has been literally "running" for five years and just keeps getting bigger and better. Jesse Jacobs, CAMPCO, Executive Vice President said, "Even in a pandemic, our 5k had more registrations and sponsors than previous years. We've seen people join from out of state and last year we had people participate virtually."

In addition to organizing the Paint Gillette Pink 5k, CAMPCO also was a champion in raising funds for the PET/CT Capital Campaign. They stepped up with a financial contribution and challenged their financial peers in the community to match. Kurt, Jesse and the CAMPCO team helped that campaign finish ahead of schedule. "We saw the need for a more compassionate and convenient care for cancer patients and was proud to support." Kurt said.

CAMPCO enters into new leadership but says the healthcare support will continue to be a priority. Matt Baker, CAMPCO President, continues Kurt's legacy of giving by donating a sizable gift to the Kid Clinic project. The Healthcare Foundation through Festival of Trees and CAMPCO donated funds to support the project that is now under construction for a much-needed new building. "This is a unique service and CAMPCO is excited to be involved," Matt stated.
