WHO WE ARE

The mission of the Northeast Wyoming Community Health Foundation is connecting our community with resources during health care challenges through philanthropic innovations. Our nonprofit organization, through the generosity of individuals, businesses and other foundations, uses resources to improve the lives of families, friends and neighbors throughout the northeast region of Wyoming.

For every dollar given to the NEW Community Health Foundation, only eleven cents is used for operations.

Our work started in 1975 as the Campbell County Healthcare Foundation serving a vision for the people of Gillette. Over four decades later, NEW Community Health has emerged to improve health for the northeast region of Wyoming. Over the years, many volunteers have shared a common goal and spirited dedication, improving the health of our families, friends and neighbors. Currently, our organization composed of a volunteer board of directors and 3 employees:

- Supports hospice patients and their families through Hospice Giving
- Provides reduced hotel costs through our Patient Lodging program in partnership with Candlewood Suites & Wingate Inn
- Provides financial support to our local cancer families through Cancer Care
- Provides financial support to help promote and prolong mental health and counselling services in our community with HOPE Source
- Provides financial oversight to enhance activities to the residents of The Legacy

In order to accomplish all our support, we focus on fund development engaging the community in estate planning, grants, major gifts, planned giving and special events.

- Managing mid-level, major gifts and planned giving programs

- Leading a capital campaign for construction and operation of a dedicated hospice house
- Report program progress to management
- Develop and execute an annual fundraising plan with a goal
- Generate new ideas that increase revenue and donor loyalty
