PENGUIN COLD CAP SYSTEM

is a 3-cap process - two caps cooling and one cap on your head.

The Penguin caps retain their cool temperature for long periods of time. This means you don't need to juggle so many caps, making the caps simple and easy to use - especially if you're doing it yourself.

HOW DOES IT WORK

It works by cooling the hair follicles on your scalp, causing them to go into hibernation, and stopping the chemotherapy drugs from penetrating the roots.



YOUR CARE

A Penguin caps representative will work with you on your personalized capping schedule (based off your chemotherapy regimen). The staff at the Heptner Cancer Center will help coordinate the capping schedule and will also be available to help with “capping” during your treatments if you don't have a family member or friend to help.
